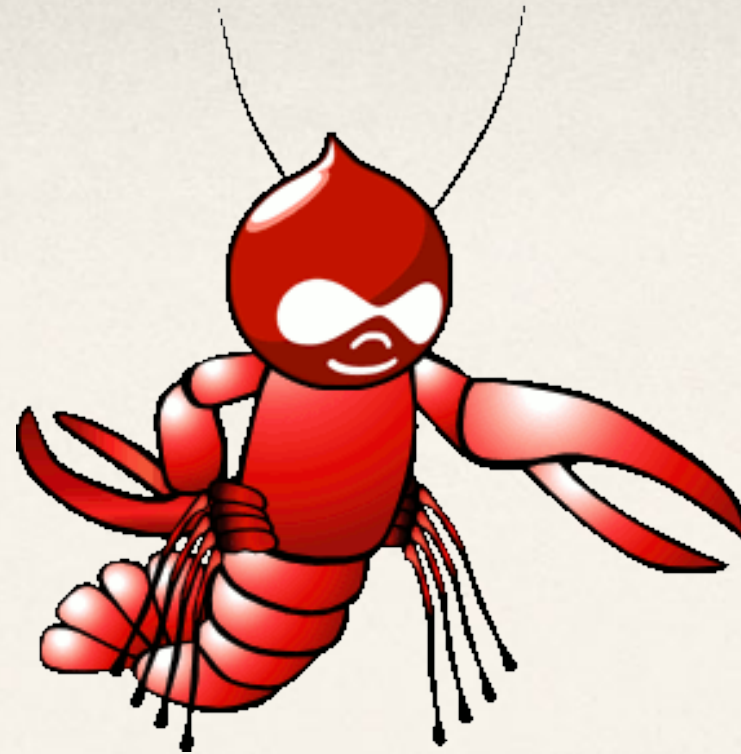

The [User Relationships module](#) allows users to create named relationships between each other.

Relationship types are defined by an administrator at: [Administer > User Management > Relationships](#)

Relationship types have a name, a plural name, a timeout, an auto approve designation and a directionality. The name can be anything. The timeout is the amount of time a request stays active. For example, if it's set to 30 days and a user requests a relationship with another user and that user doesn't accept or deny the request within 30 days the request will be dropped.

If auto approve is set, the system skips the request->approve/deny process and simply creates the relationship. An application of this might be the relationship type "subscriber." You don't necessarily need to approve of me subscribing to you.

There are only two types of directionality: two-way and one-way. An example of a two-way relationship may be "friends." If you're my friend I'm your friend. One-way relationships may be something like "manager," "follower," "stalker." You may be my manager, but I'm not yours. You have the option to allow a one way relationship to be reciprocated, but this is not enabled by default.


A user can request a relationship by visiting another user's profile and clicking the request relationship link. They can view a list of all their relationships, specific types of relationships or their pending relationship requests by visiting their own profile. Within "pending

Admins create relationship types (friend, co-worker, one-way or mutual. If a relationship type is created as relating to the requestee. Relationship type requires approval.

Admins can give users the option to auto approve on a basis.

Also bundled with the core relationships module are related:

1. **User Relationship Mailer** will (conditionally) send relationship creation/removal/approval emails.
2. **User Relationship Defaults** creates default relationship types (think Tom on MySpace).
3. **User Relationship Implications** allows for relationship types (Manager implies Coworker) that are automatically created and removed as other relationships are created.
4. **User Relationship Blocks** blocks the creation of relationships that are blocked.
5. **User Relationship Invites** requires the user to send an invite to a user that they invite to a relationship.
6. **User Relationship Views** integration with the views module and fields.
7. **User Relationship Privatemsg** integrates with the quick select list.
8. **User Relationship Migrate** allows for migrating relationships from one user to another.
9. **User Relationship Elaborations** lets users add a request to another user.
10. **User Relationship Node Access** lets users manage their relationships.
11. **User Relationship Services** exposes relationship types to other modules.
12. **User Relationship Rules** allows triggering actions on relationship approved, etc.
